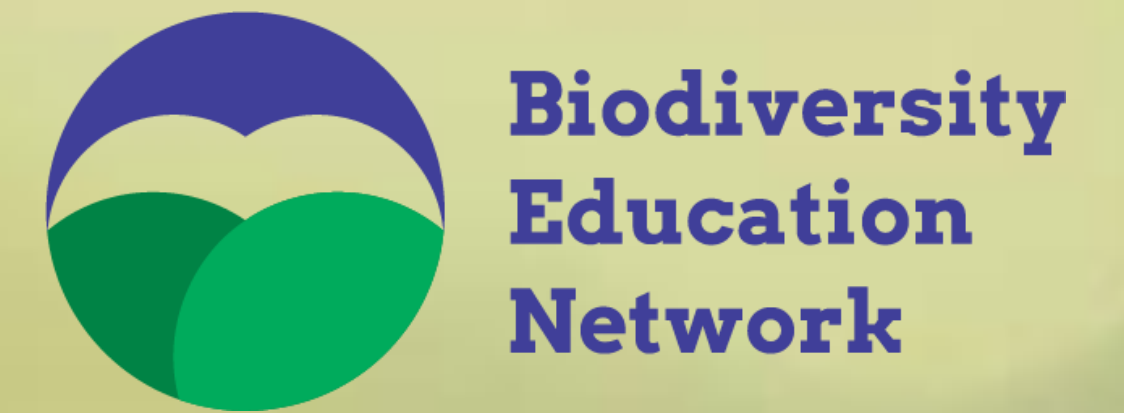

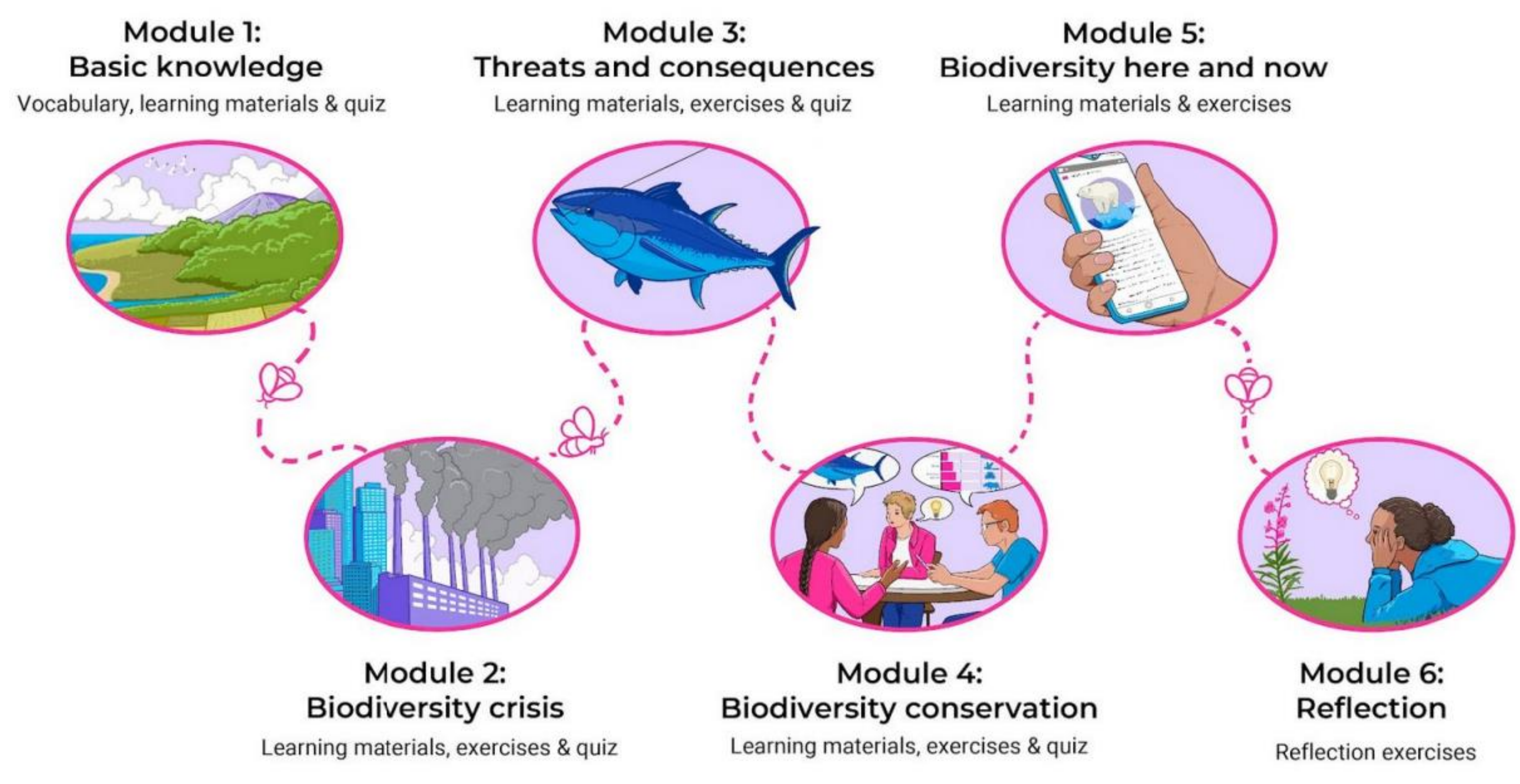

- To apply the issues to one's own field of studies/work and learn how to be part of the solution

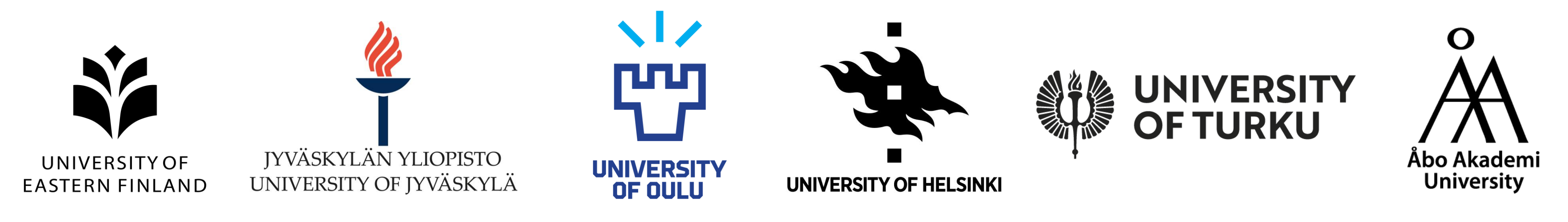
